Deadlines: Completed Application will be considered on a rolling basis.

Available Scholarships: Scholarship amounts depend on available funds. Past scholarships have ranged from \$500 to \$1,500.

Eligibility: Preference will be given to students attending a law school in Alaska, Idaho, Oregon, and Washington. Any student who is enrolled in a Tribe that located in one those states, and who is attending a law school outside of that service area, is also eligible. **Applicants must be enrolled in a federally recognized Tribe or Alaska Native, a descendant of a federally recognized Tribe or Alaska Native, or Native Hawaiian.** Applicants must also be enrolled in an ABA accredited law school.

Application Requirements:

1. A fully completed Scholarship Application form;
2. A resume;
3. Proof of tribal affiliation;
4. A copy of an admission statement from an accredited law school;
5. Two letters of recommendation (copies of recent letters submitted for law school admission, other scholarships, or internships are acceptable); and
6. A one-page essay describing your commitment and career goals as they will benefit or provide service to American Indian, Alaska Native and/or other indigenous people residing in the Northwest
