Applicants must be enrolled in a federally recognized Tribe or Alaska Native, a descendant of a federally recognized Tribe or Alaska Native, or Native Hawaiian. Applicants must also be enrolled in an ABA

accredited law school.

- 4. A copy of an admission statement from an accredited law school;
- 5. Two letters of recommendation (copies of recent letters submitted for law school admission, other scholarships, or internships are acceptable); and
- 6. A one-page essay describing your commitment and career goals as they will benefit or provide service to American Indian, Alaska Native and/or other indigenous people residing in the Northwest
